**If your Local/CLC would like to participate, please let us know by March 20<sup>th</sup> . We only have room for 15 "Grillers".**

We also need volunteers to help with whatever comes up in regards to setup, parking, clean up, garbage, etc.

**We strongly urge the grillers and their chefs to come on Tuesday, April 4, and begin setting up. Please bring plenty of lawn chairs as sitting will be limited.**
