**CALL FOR THE THIRTY-SECOND BIENNIAL CONVENTION
OF THE ALABAMA AFL-CIO**

You are hereby notified that the *Thirty-Second Biennial* convention of the *Alabama AFL-CIO* will be held at the Embassy Suite, 300 Tallapoosa Street, Montgomery, Alabama 36104. The convention will begin at 10:00 a.m., on **Monday, October 21, 2019** and will continue through **Wednesday, October 23, 2019** or until the business of the convention has been completed.

Your organization is requested to be represented by its full delegation in the convention. Many subjects of importance to organized labor will be discussed and acted upon.

CREENTIALS

Original and Duplicate Credential Forms will be sent to all affiliates under separate cover no later than the *21st of August, 2019*. Duplicate credentials (blue) must be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer, 435 South McDonough Street, Montgomery, Alabama 36104, properly filled out no later than **October 4, 2019**. **Per capita tax** must be paid through **July, 2019** for delegates to be seated.

Appointments of committees to handle much of the business of the convention must be made from credentials received prior to the convention. Delegates from your local union will not be considered for these important committees unless their credentials are received prior to **October 4, 2019**.

A registration fee of **\$125.00** per delegate should be enclosed with duplicate credentials to help defray the cost of the convention no later than **October 4, 2019**. Make all checks payable to "Convention-Alabama AFL-CIO." Original credentials (white) should be presented at the registration desk when the delegate registers.

Please do not include registration fees with per capita tax payments.

REGISTRATION

Delegates and visitors will be registered on *Sunday, October 20, from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m.*, at the Embassy Suites, 300 Tallapoosa Street, Montgomery, Alabama. Registration will begin again *Monday morning, October 21, at 8:30 a.m.* at the Embassy Suites.

Article 6, Section 9, Paragraph 3, In order that the roll call can be prepared for a roll call vote, registration of delegates shall be closed at the end of the morning session on the second day of a regular three-day biennial convention and at the end of the morning session of a special one-day convention.

RESOLUTIONS

Article 5, Section 3, of the constitution requires all resolutions to be presented in duplicate typewritten form and must be received by the Secretary-Treasurer no later than **October 4, 2019**.

CONVENTION

Article 5, Section 2, The President and Secretary-Treasurer shall issue the Convention Call at least sixty days prior to the convention and shall send sufficient credentials to each affiliated organization. Duplicate credentials must be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer of the State Federation not later than two weeks prior to the Convention. The original credential shall be presented to the Credentials Committee before the opening of the Convention. The credentials of each delegate must be signed by the President and/or Secretary of the affiliated organization that the delegate is representing.
